HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that a person's name begins with a capital letter. Model this idea with a different name, such as Tara, then read each prompt and give students time to mark their papers.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Look at the letters in each row. Listen for the name, then circle the capital letter that should begin the name.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The name is Mia. Which capital letter should begin the name Mia? Circle it.	M
b	The name is Rosa. Which capital letter should begin the name Rosa? Circle it.	R
c	The name is Theo. Which capital letter should begin the name Theo? Circle it.	T

PART 2 • TRACE NAMES

SAY “Each name begins with a capital letter. Say each name with me, then trace the gray capital letter in its box.”

- Box 1 (beside Ana): **A**
- Box 2 (beside Cole): **C**
- Box 3 (beside Jin): **J**
