HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every prompt and printed choice aloud. Students show vocabulary understanding by choosing a word for its meaning and by matching spoken words to printed marks.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • HEAR IT

SAY “Listen to each question and the three words. Circle the word that answers each question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which word means alike? I will read: same, tiny, compare. Circle the word that means alike.	same
b	Which word means look closely to see how things are alike or different? I will read: tiny, compare, same. Circle the word that means look closely.	compare
c	Which word means very small? I will read: compare, same, tiny. Circle the word that means very small.	tiny

PART 2 • SHAPE WORDS

SAY “Listen as I say each word on the left. Draw a line from each word to the shape that matches it.”

- **triangle** matches **triangle**
- **circle** matches **circle**
- **square** matches **square**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle row answers are same, compare, and tiny. Accept lines from triangle to triangle, circle to circle, and square to square.
