HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the choices aloud and have students mark their own answers in Part 1. For Part 2, give each pair one worksheet, a pencil, and scrap paper, then listen for partners to state a plan, hear each other's ideas, and take agreed roles.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • TEAM CHOICES

SAY “We will listen to little partner problems. I will read the words in each row, and you will circle the word that best helps the partners work together.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Your partner needs the blue crayon too. Which word shows working together: share, grab, or hide? Circle the word you choose.	share
b	You and your partner want to talk at the same time. Which word can help you work together: yell, wait, or push? Circle the word you choose.	wait
c	You and your partner have different ideas. Which word can help you learn your partner's idea: quit, grab, or ask? Circle the word you choose.	ask

PART 2 • OUR JOBS

SAY “With your partner, use a pencil and one piece of scrap paper to make a tiny design with one circle and one square. Ask each other, “Who will draw the circle?” and “Who will draw the square?” Take turns writing the first letters of the job helpers' names in the boxes beside the shapes.”

- Box 1 (beside circle): **First initial of the student who agreed to draw the circle.**
- Box 2 (beside square): **First initial of the student who agreed to draw the square.**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are share, wait, and ask. In Part 2, accept legible first initials that match the roles the partners agreed on and used for their two-shape design.
