HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each writing situation aloud, including the choices in the row. Students first review writing for its goal, then use a friend's feedback to decide whether the writing does its job.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MY CHECK

SAY "I will read a writer's goal and what the writer wrote. In each row, decide if the writing does the job. Circle YES, NO, or MAYBE."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A writer wants to tell people about a party. The writer wrote, "Come to my party on Saturday." The choices are NO, MAYBE, and YES. Does this writing tell people about the party?	YES
b	A writer wants to tell Dad which snack the writer wants. The writer wrote, "I like to run." The choices are YES, NO, and MAYBE. Does this writing tell Dad which snack the writer wants?	NO
c	A writer wants to tell about a pet. The writer wrote, "My pet is a fish." The choices are YES, MAYBE, and NO. Does this writing tell about the pet?	YES

PART 2 • FRIEND CHECK

SAY "Now listen to a writer's goal, writing, and a friend's words. Use the friend's words to decide if the writing does the job. Circle YES, NO, or MAYBE."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A writer wants to ask a friend to play blocks. The writer wrote, "Will you play blocks with me?" The friend says, "I know you want to play blocks." The choices are MAYBE, NO, and YES. Does the friend's feedback show that the writing does the job?	YES
b	A writer wants to tell a friend which game to play. The writer wrote, "I like yellow." The friend says, "I do not know which game you want to play." The choices are NO, YES, and MAYBE. Does the friend's feedback show that the writing does the job?	NO
c	A writer wants to tell a friend the pet's name. The writer wrote, "My pet is Spot." The friend says, "I know your pet's name is Spot." The choices are YES, MAYBE, and NO. Does the friend's feedback show that the writing does the job?	YES

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers: YES, NO, YES. Part 2 answers: YES, NO, YES. Accept a clearly circled correct word.
