HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each tiny text aloud twice before students mark a row. For example, after hearing “A bird sings,” a child can point to “sings” to show how they know what the bird does. In this sheet, students use a word from the text as a clue for each answer.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • NIA'S TEXT

SAY “I will read a tiny story two times. Listen for the words in the story: “Nia has a kite. The kite is blue. Nia runs.” Listen to each question, then circle the word from the story that is your clue.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What does Nia have? Read the words: blue, kite, runs. Which word from the story is your clue? Circle it.	kite
b	What color is the kite? Read the words: kite, runs, blue. Which word from the story is your clue? Circle it.	blue
c	What does Nia do? Read the words: runs, blue, kite. Which word from the story is your clue? Circle it.	runs

PART 2 • TOM'S TEXT

SAY “I will read a new tiny story two times. Listen for the words in the story: “Tom sees a big frog. The frog jumps.” Listen to each question, then circle the word from the story that is your clue.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What does Tom see? Read the words: big, jumps, frog. Which word from the story is your clue? Circle it.	frog
b	Which word tells about the frog's size? Read the words: frog, big, jumps. Which word from the story is your clue? Circle it.	big
c	What does the frog do? Read the words: jumps, frog, big. Which word from the story is your clue? Circle it.	jumps

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept circles on kite, blue, and runs in the first part, in row order. Accept circles on frog, big, and jumps in the second part, in row order.
