HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each short page aloud, then point to and read every choice before students circle. Students show how a title tells what a whole page is about and how a label names a part in a drawing.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • PICK A TITLE

SAY "I will read a little page. Then I will point to and read the three title choices. Which title tells what the whole page is about?"

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	This little page says, "Birds have wings. Birds make nests." The title choices are Fish, Birds, and Trees. Which title tells what the whole page is about?	Birds
b	This little page says, "Rain falls from clouds. Rain makes puddles." The title choices are Wind, Snow, and Rain. Which title tells what the whole page is about?	Rain
c	This little page says, "A seed grows into a plant." The title choices are Seeds, Rocks, and Stars. Which title tells what the whole page is about?	Seeds

PART 2 • PICK A LABEL

SAY "Labels can tell readers the names of parts in a drawing. I will tell you about a drawing, then point to and read the label choices. Which label makes the drawing clearer?"

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A drawing shows a tree. The writer wants a label for the part under the ground. The label choices are leaves, roots, and trunk. Which label makes the drawing clearer?	roots
b	A drawing shows a dog. The writer wants a label for the parts the dog uses to hear. The label choices are tail, ears, and paws. Which label makes the drawing clearer?	ears
c	A drawing shows a flower. The writer wants a label for the green part that holds the flower up. The label choices are petal, leaf, and stem. Which label makes the drawing clearer?	stem

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept circles on Birds, Rain, Seeds, roots, ears, and stem. Read the choices again or point to each choice for students who need support.
