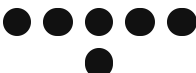

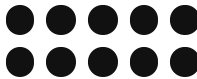
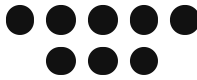

HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to touch and count each dot once. Precision looks like careful one-to-one counting, choosing the exact amount, and checking before making a mark.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Look at each row. Touch each dot as you count, then circle the group that has the exact number I say.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which group has exactly six dots? Circle it.	6 dots
b	Which group has exactly nine dots? Circle it.	9 dots
c	Which group has exactly three dots? Circle it.	3 dots

PART 2 • MATCH EXACTLY

SAY “Count each group of dots carefully. Draw a line from each number to the group of dots that shows that many.”

- **4** matches **4 dots**
- **8** matches **8 dots**
- **10** matches **10 dots**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle row answers are 6 dots, 9 dots, and 3 dots. Match 4 to 4 dots, 8 to 8 dots, and 10 to 10 dots; accept lines that clearly connect each correct pair.
