

# Pattern Power

Use equal groups to find totals and check your thinking.

## FIND THE REPEAT

When equal groups repeat, the total grows by the same amount each time. Write the same addend again and again, then check that every jump is the same size.

## WORKED EXAMPLE

A puppy has 2 treat bowls.  
Each bowl has 6 treats. How  
many treats are there?

1. One bowl has 6 treats.
2. Add 6 for the other bowl.
3.  $6 + 6 = 12$ .

**Answer: 12 treats**

| 2 | Four art boxes each hold 7 crayons. Write repeated addition and the total.                        | $7 + 7 + 7 + 7 = 28$ crayons           |
| 3 | A garden has 5 rows of 4 tulips. Write repeated addition and the total.                           | $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 20$ tulips        |

## PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **20; 20 reading points** Add 5 each day. The pattern is 5, 10, 15, 20.
2. **No. He won 24 tickets.** There are 8 groups of 3 tickets. Adding 3 eight times gives 24, not 21.

## CHALLENGE

**20 raisins. The total goes up by 5 for each new pack: 5, 10, 15, 20.**
