HUNDREDS, TENS, ONES

A three-digit number has hundreds, tens, and ones. Each digit tells how many groups are in its place. You can show a number with words, groups, or expanded form.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A toy shelf has 462 toy cars.
Show 462 in expanded form.

1. The 4 is in the hundreds place, so it means 400.
2. The 6 is in the tens place, so it means 60.
3. The 2 is in the ones place, so it means 2.
4. Add the values: $400 + 60 + 2$.

Answer: $462 = 400 + 60 + 2$

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **348 tickets** 3 hundreds is 300, 4 tens is 40, and 8 ones is 8. $300 + 40 + 8 = 348$.
2. **5 hundreds, 2 tens, and 1 one, or $500 + 20 + 1$** The 5 is worth 500, the 2 is worth 20, and the 1 is worth 1.

CHALLENGE

Yes. Both are correct because 705 has 7 hundreds, 0 tens, and 5 ones. $700 + 0 + 5 = 705$.

Accept equivalent correct forms, such as “7 hundreds, 0 tens, 5 ones” for 705. For expanded form, accept sums that show the correct place values, including 0 tens when appropriate.
