BREAK APART NUMBERS

Break each number into hundreds, tens, and ones. Add or subtract each place value, and trade 1 hundred for 10 tens or 1 ten for 10 ones when you need to.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A bin has 326 red blocks and 147 blue blocks. How many blocks are in the bin?

1. $326 = 300 + 20 + 6$.

2. $147 = 100 + 40 + 7$.

3. Add the ones: $6 + 7 = 13$.

4. Add the parts: $400 + 60 + 13 = 473$.

Answer: 473 blocks
