Read each question carefully and decide what the answer needs to tell. Write an equation, include the correct unit or label, and check that your answer makes sense. You can check division by multiplying.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Noah puts 48 stickers equally into 6 envelopes. How many stickers are in each envelope?

1. Write the equation: $48 \div 6 = \underline{\quad}$.

2. Divide: $48 \div 6 = 8$.

3. Check: $6 \times 8 = 48$.

Answer: 8 stickers in each envelope

- 7 cards on each page** Divide 84 by 12 to get 7. Check that $12 \times 7 = 84$.
- 14 centimeters** Find the width of the three photos: $3 \times 37 = 111$. Subtract 111 from 125 to get 14 centimeters.

CHALLENGE

No. $4 \times 18 = 72$, and $72 + 25 = 97$, so the scoreboard is 1 point too low.
