COMPARE WITH TIMES

When one amount is a certain number of times as many as another amount, multiply to find the larger amount. Divide to find the smaller amount or to find how many times as many one amount is.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Nora has 7 pencils. Eli has 4 times as many pencils as Nora. How many pencils does Eli have?

1. Nora has 7 pencils.
2. Eli has 4 groups of 7 pencils.
3. $7 \times 4 = 28$.

Answer: Eli has 28 pencils.
