BREAK IT APART

For multiplication, break apart one number by place value, multiply each part, and add the products. For division, use place value or long division, then check by multiplying the quotient by the divisor.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$427 \times 3$$

1. $400 \times 3 = 1,200$

2. $20 \times 3 = 60$

3. $7 \times 3 = 21$

4. $1,200 + 60 + 21 = 1,281$

Answer: 1,281
