ROUND TO HUNDREDTHS

Find the hundredths digit, which is the second digit to the right of the decimal point. Look at the thousandths digit next. If it is 5 or more, increase the hundredths digit by 1. If it is 4 or less, keep the hundredths digit the same.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Round 18.376 to the nearest hundredth.

1. The hundredths digit is 7.
2. The thousandths digit is 6.
3. Since 6 is 5 or more, increase 7 to 8.
4. Drop the digits after the hundredths place.

Answer: 18.38

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- 48.30 seconds** The hundredths digit is 0, and the thousandths digit is 2. Since 2 is less than 5, the hundredths digit stays 0.
- 2.68 minutes** The hundredths digit is 7, and the thousandths digit is 5. Since 5 means round up, 2.675 rounds to 2.68.

CHALLENGE

No. The thousandths digit is 4, so the hundredths digit stays 5, and 6.254 rounds to 6.25.

Require answers rounded to two decimal places, including zeros when needed. Accept explanations that correctly identify the thousandths digit and tell whether the hundredths digit changes.
