CHOOSE FRIENDLY FACTORS

For multiplication, you may change the order or grouping of factors to pair numbers that make whole numbers. For division, multiply by the reciprocal of the divisor first, then use multiplication properties to simplify. You can also distribute multiplication across addition or subtraction to break apart a factor.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Find $11/13 \times 26/11$.

1. Group the factors as $(11/11) \times (26/13)$.
2. $11/11 = 1$ and $26/13 = 2$.
3. $1 \times 2 = 2$.

Answer: 2

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **6 GB** Multiply $8 \times 3/4$. Group 8 and 4 first, since $8/4 = 2$, then $2 \times 3 = 6$.
2. **12 minutes** Divide $-4 \frac{1}{2}$ by $-3/8$. Rewrite $-4 \frac{1}{2}$ as $-9/2$ and multiply by the reciprocal, $(-9/2) \times (-8/3) = 12$.

CHALLENGE

$(-3/4) \times (6/5) \times (-8/15) = 12/25$

Accept equivalent fractions, mixed numbers, or decimals when they represent the same value. For the challenge, accept any correct multiplication-by-reciprocal rewrite that leads to $12/25$.
