BUILD AND TEST CLAIMS

To build a viable argument, state your claim, show a calculation or model, and connect the result to the situation. To critique a claim, check every operation and decide whether the evidence supports the conclusion. A correct answer without evidence is not a complete argument.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A club buys 7 buttons for \$42. Maya says each button costs \$6. Is Maya's claim viable?

1. Find the unit price: $42 \div 7 = 6$.
2. Check the claim: $7 \times 6 = 42$.
3. The check matches the total cost.

Answer: Yes. Maya's claim is viable because each button costs \$6.

- 1** A school dance committee has \$120 for a DJ. The DJ charges a \$48 setup fee plus \$3 for each song request. Priya says the committee can afford 24 song requests. Decide whether Priya's claim is viable, and write an argument using the costs.

CHALLENGE One step up

CHALLENGE

A club is ordering hoodies. Shop A charges a \$25 setup fee plus \$2 per hoodie. Shop B charges a \$9 setup fee plus \$4 per hoodie. Jules says Shop A is always cheaper because its cost per hoodie is lower. Critique Jules's claim. Find when the shops cost the same, then explain which shop is cheaper for smaller and larger orders.

PART 1 • PRACTICE

#	PROBLEM	ANSWER
1	At a snack stand, 4 smoothies cost \$18. Lila says each smoothie costs \$4.50. Is her claim viable? Show a calculation that supports or disproves it.	Yes. $18 / 4 = 4.50$, so each smoothie costs \$4.50.
2	A video begins at 3:25 and ends at 4:10. Mila says the video lasts 35 minutes. Is her claim viable? Explain.	No. From 3:25 to 4:00 is 35 minutes, and 10 more minutes pass before 4:10. The video lasts 45 minutes.
3	A game downloads 2.5 GB in 5 minutes at a constant rate. Ren says an 8 GB download will take 16 minutes. Is Ren's reasoning viable? Show your evidence.	Yes. $2.5 / 5 = 0.5$ GB per minute, and $8 / 0.5 = 16$ minutes.
4	Tari has \$30 and saves \$9 each week for 5 weeks. Tari says there will be \$75 at the end. Is this claim viable? Show a calculation.	Yes. $30 + 9(5) = 30 + 45 = 75$, so Tari will have \$75.
5	A weather app shows a morning temperature of -3 degrees. The temperature rises 8 degrees, then drops 5 degrees. Kim says the final temperature is 0 degrees. Is Kim correct? Explain.	Yes. $-3 + 8 - 5 = 0$, so the final temperature is 0 degrees.
6	On a map, 1 cm represents 14 km. A route measures 2.5 cm. Noah says the real route is 40 km. Critique Noah's claim.	No. $14 \times 2.5 = 35$, so the real route is 35 km, not 40 km.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- Priya's claim is viable. The cost of 24 requests is $\$48 + \$3(24) = \$120$, which matches the committee's budget.**
Substitute 24 for the number of requests. The total equals the budget, so the claim is supported.
- Diego's claim is not viable. Using 10 GB costs $\$12 + \$2(10) = \$32$, which is over budget. Sam can use at most 9 GB because $\$12 + \$2(9) = \$30$.** Write $12 + 2x \leq 30$ and subtract 12 to get $2x \leq 18$. Dividing by 2 gives $x \leq 9$.

CHALLENGE

Jules's claim is incomplete. Set the costs equal: $25 + 2x = 9 + 4x$. Then $16 = 2x$, so $x = 8$. At 8 hoodies, both shops cost \$41. Shop B is cheaper for fewer than 8 hoodies, and Shop A is cheaper for more than 8 hoodies.

Accept equivalent calculations and wording when students correctly state whether each claim is supported and include relevant evidence. For the challenge, accept an equivalent table, equation, or comparison that identifies the equal-cost point and which shop is cheaper on each side of it.
