HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that a producer makes something or provides a service for others. A consumer buys or uses something, and the same person can be both at different times. Read every choice aloud and have students make the marks themselves.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each story. I will read the three choices in the row. In the action I tell you about, is the person a producer, a consumer, or both? Circle your answer.”

a	Ava makes bracelets to sell at a market. Is Ava a producer, a consumer, or both? Circle your answer.	PRODUCER
b	Noah buys a notebook to use at school. Is Noah a producer, a consumer, or both? Circle your answer.	CONSUMER
c	Mia grows flowers to sell. Later, she buys a hat. Is Mia a producer, a consumer, or both? Circle your answer.	BOTH
