HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use a classroom world map or globe. Before students begin, place paper number tags beside the continents: 1 North America, 2 South America, 3 Africa, 4 Europe, 5 Asia, 6 Antarctica, and 7 Australia. Students find each continent on the map, then record or match its number tag on the page.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • WRITE TAGS

SAY “Find North America and South America on the map. What two number tags do you see from north to south, and can you write those digits together in the N/S box? Find Africa, what number tag is beside it, and can you write it in the AF box?”

- Box 1 (beside N/S): **12**
- Box 2 (beside AF): **3**

PART 2 • MATCH TAGS

SAY “Find Europe, Asia, Antarctica, and Australia on the map. For each code on the left, what numbered map tag belongs with the continent I name, EU is Europe, AS is Asia, AN is Antarctica, and AU is Australia? Draw each line to its number.”

- **EU** matches **4**
- **AS** matches **5**
- **AN** matches **6**
- **AU** matches **7**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept 12 in the N/S box and 3 in the AF box. Lines should be EU to 4, AS to 5, AN to 6, and AU to 7; observe that each student finds the named continent on the map before recording.
