HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use this sheet after students have explored a world map. Read each row aloud, and have students use the location clue to circle the matching ocean name.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FIND IT

SAY "I will read the ocean words in each row and then ask a question. Listen for the ocean that fits the location clue, then circle that word."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Atlantic, Pacific, Arctic. Which ocean is around the North Pole? Circle its word.	Arctic
b	Listen: Atlantic, Pacific, Indian. Which ocean is between the Americas and Europe and Africa? Circle its word.	Atlantic
c	Listen: Southern, Pacific, Atlantic. Which ocean is between the Americas and Asia and Australia? Circle its word.	Pacific

PART 2 • MORE OCEANS

SAY "Now listen to the ocean words and the location clue. Which word names the ocean in that place? Circle it."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Arctic, Southern, Indian. Which ocean goes all around Antarctica? Circle its word.	Southern
b	Listen: Indian, Atlantic, Pacific. Which ocean is south of Asia, east of Africa, and west of Australia? Circle its word.	Indian
