HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each clue aloud and give students time to look across the large words before they mark. Students show they can identify mountains and valleys from spoken descriptions, then connect all four landform names to simple clue words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "Listen to each clue. I will read the land words in the row. Circle the land word that matches the clue."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which land word names very high land that rises above the land around it?	mountain
b	Which land word names low land between hills or mountains?	valley

PART 2 • MATCH CLUES

SAY "Draw a line from each land word on the left to its clue word on the right. I will read the words as you look: high, dry, lowland, and seaside. Which clue goes with each landform?"

- **mountain** matches **high**
- **desert** matches **dry**
- **valley** matches **lowland**
- **coast** matches **seaside**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle mountain in row 1 and valley in row 2. Match mountain to high, desert to dry, valley to lowland, and coast to seaside.
