HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Students listen to clues about land and water features, then identify the matching printed word. Before beginning, orally review that an island is land surrounded by water, then read each word and clue aloud. Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "Listen as I read the words in each row. Listen to each clue, then circle the word that answers the question."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The choices are river, mountain, and valley. What word names very high land that rises above the land around it?	mountain
b	The choices are lake, ocean, and river. What word names water that flows across land?	river
c	The choices are lake, ocean, and plain. What word names water with land all around it?	lake

PART 2 • MATCH WORDS

SAY "Look at the feature words on the left and the clue words on the right. Draw a line from each feature word to the clue word that fits it."
