Executive Leaders

- ① People elect leaders to help run the country, state, and city. These leaders are part of the executive branch. The President leads the United States. The President works at the White House in Washington, D.C.
- ② In Georgia, voters elect a governor. The governor leads the state government. The governor works at the Georgia State Capitol in Atlanta. The capitol is where state leaders meet and make many state decisions.
- ③ In a city, people elect a mayor. The mayor leads the city government. The mayor works at City Hall. A mayor may work with city workers to help keep streets, parks, and other city places running well.
