HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each job name and work description aloud. Students show that they can describe what people do by choosing the worker whose job matches the spoken description and by matching job names to work words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE JOBS

SAY “Look at the job names in each row. I will read the names and tell you about some work people do. Listen, then circle the job name that answers each question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The choices are Teacher, Farmer, and Doctor. Which person helps sick people feel better? Circle the job name.	Doctor
b	The choices are Soldier, Firefighter, and Teacher. Which person puts out fires and helps in an emergency? Circle the job name.	Firefighter
c	The choices are Farmer, Mail carrier, and Teacher. Which person brings letters and packages to homes? Circle the job name.	Mail carrier

PART 2 • MATCH WORK

SAY “Look at the job names on the left and the work words on the right. I will read both columns. Which work word goes with each job name? Draw a line to match each pair.”

- **Doctor** matches **Patients**
- **Farmer** matches **Crops**
- **Firefighter** matches **Fires**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle Doctor in row 1, Firefighter in row 2, and Mail carrier in row 3. Match Doctor to Patients, Farmer to Crops, and Firefighter to Fires.
