HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every row and every choice aloud while students point, then circle their answers. Invite students to explain orally what people can earn by working, using their own words or the words work and money. Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • JOB ACTIONS

SAY "I will read the words in each row. Listen to the worker story and circle the action the worker is paid to do."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A baker works at a bakery. Which action is the baker paid to do: nap, bake, or swim? Circle one word.	BAKE
b	A teacher works at a school. Which action is the teacher paid to do: play, teach, or sleep? Circle one word.	TEACH
c	A worker works at a car wash. Which action is the worker paid to do: wash, dance, or nap? Circle one word.	WASH

PART 2 • EARN IT

SAY "Listen to each worker story. Circle what each worker can earn from a job. Then tell a partner what people can earn by working."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A gardener cares for plants as a job. What can the gardener earn from working: money, a toy, or a cookie? Circle one word.	MONEY
b	A bus driver drives people as a job. What can the driver earn from working: a ball, money, or a nap? Circle one word.	MONEY

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Job Actions answers are BAKE, TEACH, and WASH. Earn It answers are MONEY and MONEY. Accept an oral explanation such as, "People work to earn money."
