HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use two large, clear visual flag cards or classroom flags for the United States and Georgia. Students look at each flag, listen to the question, and mark its name or first letter.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "I will hold up one flag at a time. Look closely at the flag, listen to each question, and circle the name you choose."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE

b	Look at this flag. Is it the USA flag, the Georgia flag, or the Texas flag? Circle its name.	Georgia

PART 2 • WRITE A LETTER

SAY "Place the two flags above the boxes with the number cards I show. Look at each flag. What first letter does its name begin with? Write that letter in the box."

- Box 1 (beside 1): **U**
- Box 2 (beside 2): **G**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

For the two circle rows, show the United States flag first and the Georgia flag second. For the boxes, place the United States flag at 1 and the Georgia flag at 2, accept uppercase or lowercase U and G.
