A Field and a Log

- ① A class looked closely at two places near their school: a sunny field and a shady log. They used their eyes and listened quietly. In each place, they noticed living things, including plants and animals.
- ② In the field, the students saw tall grass, small flowers, and low leafy plants. A winged insect flew over the flowers. Small crawling animals moved on the ground, and an animal with feathers called from a fence. The field had many kinds of living things.
- ③ Near the log, students found green moss and tiny plants growing in cracks. Small crawling animals moved under loose bark. A many-legged animal crossed the damp ground. The log place also had many kinds of living things.

3	How are the field and the log alike in the living things they have?	Both places had many kinds of living things, including plants and animals.
