HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that some words tell how someone feels, and some words tell what something is like to see, hear, smell, taste, or feel. Model with the sentence, "The blanket is fuzzy," and ask students to listen for the word that tells what a hand might feel. Read each row aloud, then have students circle one word.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FEELING WORDS

SAY "Look at the words in each row. I will read a sentence and then read the words. Which word tells a feeling? Circle it."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: "I feel proud." The words are I, feel, proud. Which word tells the feeling? Circle it.	proud
b	Listen: "Mia is sad." The words are sad, Mia, is. Which word tells the feeling? Circle it.	sad
c	Listen: "We are scared." The words are We, scared, are. Which word tells the feeling? Circle it.	scared

PART 2 • SENSE WORDS

SAY "Look at the words in each row. I will read a sentence and then read the words. Which word tells what something is like for a sense? Circle it."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: "The flower smells sweet." The words are flower, smells, sweet. Which word tells what the flower smells like? Circle it.	sweet
b	Listen: "Sand feels rough." The words are Sand, rough, feels. Which word tells what sand feels like? Circle it.	rough
c	Listen: "The drum sounds loud." The words are loud, drum, sounds. Which word tells what the drum sounds like? Circle it.	loud

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Feeling Words answers are proud, sad, scared. Sense Words answers are sweet, rough, loud.
