**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

In a shared discussion, children make room for one another and use respectful words. Read all choices aloud, give quiet thinking time, and invite partners to take turns before students mark the page.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CHOOSE A TURN**

**SAY** “I will read each row. Think about how you can join a group talk with a classmate or an adult, then circle the choice that helps the talk.”

**PART 2 • TALK PARTNERS**

**SAY** “On the left are words one person may say. On the right are words that go with them. Can you and your partner take turns finding and drawing each matching line?”

- **HELLO** matches **HI**
- **QUESTION** matches **ASK**
- **GOODBYE** matches **BYE**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Circle answers are LISTEN, SPEAK, and WAIT. Match HELLO to HI, QUESTION to ASK, and GOODBYE to BYE. Accept close lines and observe whether partners take turns during the matching task.
