- ② Nora added, "Leo's idea about shade makes me think of beans. Beans could grow where sunflowers do not block the light." Sam said, "I want beans too, but they need something to climb up."
- ③ Mia said, "Sam said beans climb, so we can use small sticks." Leo said, "That builds on Mia's plan. The sticks can help the beans grow beside the sunflowers." Jada added, "I agree. Leo's sticks solve Sam's climbing problem."

2	Sam says, "I want beans too." Which student's idea is Sam building on?	Sam is building on Nora's idea about planting beans.
3	How does Jada's comment connect Leo's idea to Sam's comment?	Jada says Leo's sticks solve Sam's problem because Sam said the beans need something to climb.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

Ava: We could make a reading corner with pillows. Noah: I agree with Ava because pillows make the corner cozy. Zoe: Noah's cozy idea makes me think we should add a soft rug. Eli: That builds on Zoe's rug plan, and we can sit on the rug to read.
