- ① Mia gave a short talk about her bean plant. First, she held up a large drawing. The drawing showed a seed under soil, a small sprout, and a tall plant. It helped listeners see how the plant changed.
- ② On the screen, Mia showed three photos that her dad took each week. The first photo had no leaves. The last photo had many leaves. The photos helped her classmates believe that the bean plant grew taller.
- ③ Mia ended with a bright yellow sun picture beside the words, "Plants need light." She chose the sun picture because it matched her main idea. The picture also made her feel hopeful about caring for the plant.

1	Which visual display helped listeners see how the bean plant changed?	The large drawing showing the seed, sprout, and tall plant.
2	How did the weekly photos support Mia's idea that her bean plant grew?	The photos showed no leaves at first and many leaves later, helping classmates believe the plant grew taller.
3	Why did Mia choose the sun picture, and what feeling did it show?	It matched her idea that plants need light, and it showed that she felt hopeful about caring for the plant.

My drawing shows a turtle tucked inside its hard shell. It helps listeners understand that a shell protects a turtle, and it shows that I care about keeping turtles safe.
