HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud before students mark any answers. Students show they can identify a character, a setting detail, a major event, and important information they hear.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • STORY CLUES

SAY “Listen to this story: Mia and Ben sit by one pond. Mia finds a blue scarf, and Ben helps Mia hang it on a fence so its owner can see it. After I read each question and the words in its row, circle one answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Who finds the scarf? Listen to the words: Mia, Ben, Scarf. Which word answers the question?	Mia
b	Where do Mia and Ben sit? Listen to the words: Fence, Pond, Scarf. Which word answers the question?	Pond
c	What do Mia and Ben do with the scarf so its owner can see it? Listen to the words: Find, Sit, Hang. Which word answers the question?	Hang

PART 2 • APPLE FACTS

SAY “Listen to these apple facts: Apples grow on trees, an apple can be red, green, or yellow, and seeds are inside an apple. After I read each question and the words in its row, circle one answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What grows on trees? Listen to the words: Seeds, Leaves, Apples. Which word answers the question?	Apples
b	What can be an apple color? Listen to the words: Red, Tree, Seeds. Which word answers the question?	Red
c	What is inside an apple? Listen to the words: Tree, Seeds, Green. Which word answers the question?	Seeds

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Story Clues answers are Mia, Pond, Hang. Apple Facts answers are Apples, Red, Seeds. Accept a clearly circled answer, even if the circle is large or uneven.
