HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each short text and each choice aloud. Students listen for a specific detail, then circle the word that answers the question or supports the stated idea.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FIND DETAILS

SAY “I will read a short text and the words in each row. Can you listen for the word that answers the question and circle it?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: The bus is yellow. It stops at the school. The words are school, yellow, bus. Which word tells the bus's color? Circle it.	yellow
b	Listen: The kitten sleeps on a soft rug. The words are soft, kitten, sleeps. Which word tells how the rug feels? Circle it.	soft
c	Listen: Lee has three blue blocks. The words are blue, Lee, three. Which word tells how many blocks Lee has? Circle it.	three

PART 2 • SHOW IDEAS

SAY “Now listen for a detail that helps show an idea from the text. Can you circle the word that gives the best detail?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: It rained all night. Puddles cover the sidewalk. The words are puddles, night, sidewalk. Which word is a detail that supports the idea that the ground is wet? Circle it.	puddles
b	Listen: Jin packs a folder in a backpack. The words are packs, folder, Jin. Which word is a detail that supports the idea that Jin has a school supply? Circle it.	folder
c	Listen: Omar's lunch has a sandwich and an orange. The words are lunch, Omar, sandwich. Which word names food that supports the idea that Omar has food for lunch? Circle it.	sandwich

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are yellow, soft, three. Part 2 answers are puddles, folder, sandwich. Accept a clear circle around the correct word.
