HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Model how to begin at the left and slide a finger across each row before moving down. Read the rows aloud while pointing to each word in order. Then use a classroom book to observe students tracking words and turning pages in sequence.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • TRACK WORDS

SAY “Look at the top row first. I will point to the words from left to right, then we will move down to the next row. Listen carefully and circle your answer for each row.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen as I point from left to right: cat, dog, fish. Which word did I say first? Circle it.	cat
b	Listen as I point from left to right: jump, play, rest. Which word did I say last? Circle it.	rest
c	Listen as I point from left to right: up, down, stop. Which word did I say in the middle? Circle it.	down

PART 2 • TURN PAGES

SAY “Open a classroom book with me. As I point to words, move your finger from left to right on the first page, then turn one page each time I say, “next page.” After we visit three pages, can you trace the numbers in the boxes from left to right?”

- Box 1: **1**
- Box 2: **2**
- Box 3: **3**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

For Track Words, accept cat, rest, and down, in that order. For Turn Pages, accept traced 1, 2, and 3 from left to right while observing that the student follows the book one page at a time.
