HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each choice aloud before students mark it. Students show letter recognition by circling named letters and connecting capital letters to their lowercase partners.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Look at the letters in each row. Listen as I name the letters, then circle the letter I ask for.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Look at B, D, and R. Which letter is capital R? Circle it.	R
b	Look at n, m, and h. Which letter is lowercase m? Circle it.	m

PART 2 • MATCH LETTERS

SAY “Say the capital letter in the left column with me. Can you draw a line from each capital letter to the same letter written in lowercase?”

- **A** matches **a**
- **F** matches **f**
- **L** matches **l**
- **T** matches **t**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle R in the first row and m in the second row. Lines should connect A to a, F to f, L to l, and T to t.
