HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each problem aloud, then give students time to look at the choices or write in a box. Students show fluency by quickly finding sums and differences within 10 without needing to count every dot.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE DOTS

SAY “Listen to each math question. Look at the dot groups in the row, then circle the dots that show the answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What is 3 plus 4? Circle the dots that show the answer.	7 dots
b	What is 9 minus 7? Circle the dots that show the answer.	2 dots
c	What is 8 minus 2? Circle the dots that show the answer.	6 dots

PART 2 • WRITE ANSWERS

SAY “Listen for the math question for each box. What number is the answer? Write the number in the box.”

- Box 1: **8**
- Box 2: **6**
- Box 3: **9**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle rows: 7 dots, 2 dots, 6 dots. For the three writing boxes, read 5 plus 3, 10 minus 4, and 1 plus 8 from left to right, accept 8, 6, and 9.
