Read hundreds, tens, and ones in three-digit numbers.

NY-2.NBT.1 "Understand that the digits of a three-digit number represent amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones."

HUNDREDS, TENS, ONES

In a three-digit number, the first digit tells hundreds, the middle digit tells tens, and the last digit tells ones. A digit can have a different value depending on its place.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A box holds 472 beads. Show the value of each digit.

1. The 4 is in the hundreds place, so it means 400.
2. The 7 is in the tens place, so it means 70.
3. The 2 is in the ones place, so it means 2.
4. Write $400 + 70 + 2 = 472$.

Answer: $400 + 70 + 2 = 472$

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **80** The 8 is in the tens place. It means 8 tens, or 80.
2. **306** Put 3 in the hundreds place, 0 in the tens place, and 6 in the ones place.

CHALLENGE

The first 9 is in the hundreds place, so it means 900. The last 9 is in the ones place, so it means 9.

Accept expanded form with the zero tens omitted for 608, such as $600 + 8$. For problem 3, accept "4 tens" or "40" if the student identifies the tens value.
