Add and subtract hundreds, tens, and ones.

NY-2.NBT.7.b "Understand that in adding or subtracting up to three-digit numbers, one adds or subtracts hundreds and hundreds, tens and tens, ones and ones, and sometimes it is necessary to compose or decompose tens or hundreds."

TRADE WHEN NEEDED

Line up hundreds, tens, and ones. Add or subtract the same places. If you have too many or too few in one place, trade 10 ones for 1 ten or 10 tens for 1 hundred.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Ava has 146 shell stickers. She gets 128 more shell stickers. How many shell stickers does she have now?

1. Ones: $6 + 8 = 14$ ones.
2. Regroup 14 ones as 1 ten and 4 ones.
3. Tens: $4 + 2 + 1 = 7$ tens.
4. Hundreds: $1 + 1 = 2$ hundreds.

Answer: 274 shell stickers
