CHOOSE AN OPERATION

Read the story and decide what changes. Add when the amount grows or when you put parts together. Subtract when the amount gets smaller or when you compare two amounts.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Ava has 27 stickers. She gets 16 more stickers. How many stickers does Ava have now?

1. Start with 27 stickers.
2. Add 16 more stickers.
3. $27 + 16 = 43$.

Answer: 43 stickers
