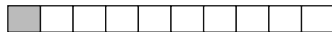

ONE PART

One shaded part out of equal parts is a unit fraction. It names one part of the whole.

A bar is split into 10 equal parts. One part is shaded, so the shaded part is $\frac{1}{10}$.



MORE PARTS

Two or more shaded equal parts do not show one unit fraction. They show more than one part of the whole.

A bar is split into 10 equal parts. Three parts are shaded, so the shading is more than one part.

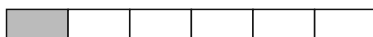

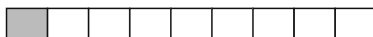

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **ONE PART:** A bar divided into 11 equal parts with 1 part shaded.
- **MORE PARTS:** A bar divided into 11 equal parts with 4 parts shaded.

Challenge: A rectangle split into 12 equal parts with 1 part shaded. The unit fraction is $\frac{1}{12}$.

For Part 2, accept explanations that name the total equal parts and tell whether exactly one part or more than one part is shaded. In Part 3, students may use any number of equal parts as long as each drawing matches its category.
