

Tile It, Multiply It

Use rows of square tiles to find rectangle area.

NY-3.MD.7.a "Find the area of a rectangle with whole-number side lengths by tiling it, and show that the area is the same as would be found by multiplying the side lengths."

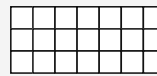
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TILES MAKE AREA

Area tells how many equal square tiles cover a rectangle. Count the rows and the tiles in each row, then multiply to find the total number of tiles. The total number of tiles is the area in square units.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Look at the tiled rectangle. Find its area.

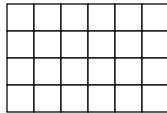


1. There are 3 rows.
2. There are 7 tiles in each row.
3. $3 \times 7 = 21$ tiles.
4. The area is 21 square units.

Answer: 21 square units

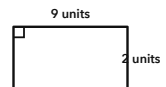

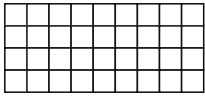

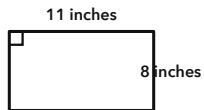
APPLY IT Show your work

CHALLENGE One step up

Rectangle A has 4 rows of 10 unit tiles. Rectangle B has 5 rows of 8 unit tiles. Do the rectangles have the same area? Explain with multiplication.

2	Look at the rectangle. Imagine covering it with unit square tiles. Write a multiplication sentence and the area.	$9 \times 2 = 18$; 18 square units
3	A game board has 8 rows of square spaces. Each row has 2 spaces. Write a multiplication sentence and find the area.	$8 \times 2 = 16$; 16 square units
4	A rectangle is 6 units long and 5 units wide. It is covered exactly by unit square tiles. How many tiles cover it? Write a multiplication sentence.	$6 \times 5 = 30$; 30 tiles
5	Mia says an 8 by 4 rectangle has an area of 12 square units because $8 + 4 = 12$. Find the correct area. Write a multiplication sentence.	$8 \times 4 = 32$; 32 square units
6	A rectangle has 10 rows of tiles with 9 tiles in each row. Find the area.	90 square units

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- 36 square feet** There are 4 rows with 9 tiles in each row. Multiply 4×9 to get 36 square feet.
- 88 stickers** The banner is 11 inches by 8 inches. Multiply 11×8 to get 88 square inches, so Ava needs 88 stickers.

CHALLENGE

Yes. $4 \times 10 = 40$ and $5 \times 8 = 40$, so both rectangles have an area of 40 square units.

Accept multiplication factors in either order. Accept correct area units when students include them.
