HAS FOUR SIDES

A quadrilateral is a closed figure with exactly four straight sides. Rectangles, squares, rhombuses, parallelograms, trapezoids, and kites are subcategories of quadrilaterals, so each has four sides.

Example: This kite has four straight sides.



DOES NOT HAVE FOUR SIDES

A figure belongs here if it does not have exactly four straight sides. It may have fewer sides, more sides, or a curved edge.

Example: This semicircle has a curved edge, so it is not a quadrilateral.

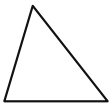

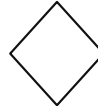

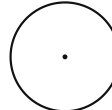

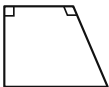

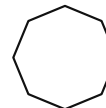

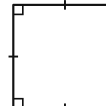

CHALLENGE

A square is a kind of rectangle, and a rectangle is a kind of quadrilateral. What property must every square have? Explain using the category chain.

#	ITEM	CATEGORY	WHY
1	Figure 1 (triangle)	NOT FOUR	A triangle has three straight sides.
2	Figure 2 (rhombus)	FOUR SIDES	A rhombus is a quadrilateral with four straight sides.
3	Figure 3 (parallelogram)	FOUR SIDES	A parallelogram is a quadrilateral with four straight sides.
4	Figure 4 (circle)	NOT FOUR	A circle has a curved edge and no straight sides.
5	Figure 5 (right trapezoid)	FOUR SIDES	A right trapezoid has four straight sides.
6	Figure 6 (octagon)	NOT FOUR	An octagon has eight straight sides.
7	Figure 7 (pentagon)	NOT FOUR	A pentagon has five straight sides.
8	Figure 8 (square)	FOUR SIDES	A square is a quadrilateral with four straight sides.

PART 2 • PROVE IT

Accept any explanation that names the deciding feature from the rule box for the chosen item.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **FOUR SIDES:** Has four sides: A student draws and names a parallelogram.
- **NOT FOUR:** Does not have four sides: A student draws and names a heptagon.

Challenge: Every square has four straight sides. A square is a rectangle, every rectangle is a quadrilateral, and all quadrilaterals have four straight sides.

Accept explanations that correctly count the visible straight sides or identify a curved edge. Emphasize that a property of the larger category, quadrilateral, also belongs to its subcategories, including rectangles and squares.
