These figures have at least one pair of sides that stay the same distance apart and never meet. A figure may have one pair, two pairs, or more.

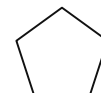
This hexagon has pairs of opposite sides that are parallel.

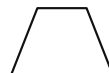

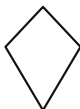

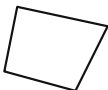

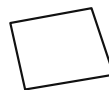

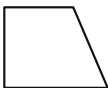

Name a figure with two pairs of parallel sides and explain why it belongs in PARALLEL.

#	ITEM	CATEGORY	WHY
1	Figure 1 (parallelogram)	PARALLEL	A parallelogram has two pairs of parallel sides.
2	Figure 2 (trapezoid)	PARALLEL	A trapezoid has at least one pair of parallel sides.
3	Figure 3 (kite)	NONE	This kite has no pairs of parallel sides.
4	Figure 4 (square)	PARALLEL	A square has two pairs of parallel sides.
5	Figure 5 (polygon)	NONE	No two sides of this quadrilateral are parallel.
6	Figure 6 (polygon)	NONE	No two sides of this quadrilateral are parallel.
7	Figure 7 (right trapezoid)	PARALLEL	A right trapezoid has at least one pair of parallel sides.
8	Figure 8 (rectangle)	PARALLEL	A rectangle has two pairs of parallel sides.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **PARALLEL:** A rhombus.
- **NONE:** A triangle.

Challenge: A rectangle belongs in PARALLEL because it has two pairs of parallel sides.
