

Number Choice Challenge

Students compare written numerals from 1 to 10 by choosing the greater or smaller number.

NY-K.CC.7 "Compare two numbers between 1 and 10 presented as written numerals."

2 SMALLER NUMBER

HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row aloud and give students time to circle one large numeral. Students show this skill when they can look at two written numerals and choose which number is greater or smaller, even when another numeral is included as a distractor.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • GREATER NUMBER

SAY "Listen for the two numbers I name. In each row, circle the number that is greater."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which number is greater, 3 or 7? Circle it.	7
b	Which number is greater, 9 or 4? Circle it.	9
c	Which number is greater, 2 or 6? Circle it.	6

PART 2 • SMALLER NUMBER

SAY "Listen for the two numbers I name. In each row, circle the number that is smaller."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which number is smaller, 8 or 5? Circle it.	5
b	Which number is smaller, 1 or 7? Circle it.	1
c	Which number is smaller, 9 or 3? Circle it.	3

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept one clear circle around the correct numeral in each row. Answers in order are 7, 9, 6, 5, 1, and 3.
