**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each prompt aloud, then pause so students can use fingers or quiet counting. Students show fluency by choosing or writing the number for a small total or amount left.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CIRCLE IT**

**SAY** “Listen to each little number story. I will read the choices, then circle the number that answers the question.”

**PART 2 • WRITE IT**

**SAY** “At the first box, look at the dots. If 2 dots are taken away, how many dots are left? Write the number in the box. At the second box, look at the dots. If 3 more dots join them, how many dots are there? Write the number in the box.”

- Box 1 (beside 5 dots): **3**
- Box 2 (beside 2 dots): **5**
