HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each story aloud and repeat the choices as needed. Students listen for ways families can include different people and for details families may share.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “I will tell you about two families in each row. Listen closely, then circle the word that answers the question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Sam lives with his dad and grandma. Lee lives with her mom and brother. Both families help each other. I will read the words: Care, Dad, Brother. Which word tells something both families do?	Care
b	Listen: Ari's family has two moms. Jo's family has an aunt. I will read the words: Moms, Aunt, Families. Which word tells what Ari and Jo both have?	Families
c	Listen: Kim's family cooks together on Friday. Bo's family plays a game together on Friday. I will read the words: Cook, Friday, Game. Which word tells something that is the same?	Friday

PART 2 • MATCH FAMILIES

SAY “Listen to these family stories. Nia calls her aunt family, Omar calls his dad family, and Pia calls her sister family. I will read the people on the right. Draw a line from each name to the person in that family.”
