HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each situation and all choices aloud. Students identify responsible actions that help people and care for shared resources.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • GOOD CHOICES

SAY “Listen to each short story and the three words in its row. Which word names the responsible choice?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A classmate is speaking. Listen: Wait, Shout, Grab. Which action shows respect?	Wait
b	Sam finds someone else's coin. Listen: Keep, Tell, Hide. Which action is honest?	Tell
c	A student drops crayons. Listen: Laugh, Leave, Help. Which action is caring?	Help

PART 2 • COMMUNITY CARE

SAY “Listen to each short story and the three words in its row. Which word names the responsible choice?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The rule is to clean hands before snack. Listen: Wash, Skip, Splash. Which action follows it?	Wash
b	Maya wants to learn the game rules. Listen: Guess, Ask, Ignore. Which action helps her learn?	Ask
c	A group has one glue stick. Listen: Hoard, Toss, Share. Which action helps everyone use it?	Share

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept circles around Wait, Tell, Help, Wash, Ask, and Share, in row order. Students may point to a choice first, then circle it with support.
