HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that people around the world may have different homes, languages, and traditions. Explain that global citizens care for people everywhere and care for Earth, such as by turning off a faucet when they are done. Read every choice aloud, then let students make their own marks.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE CARE

SAY "Listen to each short story and the three words. Think about a caring choice for people and our world, then circle one word."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A child from another place shares an idea with the class. The words are respect, laugh, and ignore. Which word shows how to treat the child? Circle it.	RESPECT
b	Your paper has a blank side that you can still use. The words are toss, reuse, and tear. Which word shows a way to care for our world? Circle it.	REUSE
c	You want to learn about a classmate's family tradition. The words are shout, leave, and listen. Which word shows a respectful choice? Circle it.	LISTEN

PART 2 • MATCH CARE

SAY "I will read the words in both columns. Draw a line from each word on the left to the action on the right that goes with it."

- **PAPER** matches **REUSE**
- **WATER** matches **SAVE**
- **NAMES** matches **SAY**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle RESPECT, REUSE, LISTEN. Example matches: PAPER to REUSE, WATER to SAVE, NAMES to SAY. Accept PAPER to SAVE or WATER to REUSE with a sensible explanation. For NAMES, discuss learning how to say a person's name respectfully.
