HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row and each column aloud. Students show their thinking by circling a time word or drawing lines between a time word and an example.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE TIME

SAY “Listen to each family event. I will read the choices in every row, then you will circle the word that answers the question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A family picnic was in summer. A family visit happened in the season after summer. Read spring, fall, winter. Which season could the family visit be in? Circle the word.	fall
b	One family photo was taken in 2022. Another family photo was taken in 2024. Read after, before, same. Which word tells when the 2024 photo was taken compared with the 2022 photo? Circle the word.	after

PART 2 • MATCH TIME

SAY “Look at the time words on the left and the examples on the right. I will read them aloud. Draw a line from each time word to the example that matches it.”

- **day** matches **Monday**
- **week** matches **7 days**
- **month** matches **April**
- **year** matches **2024**

Circle fall in the first row and after in the second row. Match day to Monday, week to 7 days, month to April, and year to 2024.
