A Visit to Town Market

- ① On Saturday, Maya visits the town market with her dad. At one booth, a baker sells warm bread. The baker mixes, shapes, and bakes the bread. Customers take the bread home to eat. Bread is a good because it is something the baker made.
- ② Near the market, Mr. Lee cuts hair at his barbershop. He listens to each customer and uses tools carefully. A haircut is a service because Mr. Lee uses his skill to do an action for someone.
- ③ Other workers help the community in different ways. A woodworker makes chairs, which are goods. A bus driver takes people to school and work. The ride is a service because the driver uses driving skills to help people travel.
