Work in Salento

- ① In Salento, a mountain community in Colombia, many small farms grow coffee beans, a good that people buy to make drinks. The community also provides guiding services for visitors. Trained guides lead walks through coffee farms and forests, sharing information about plants, animals, and local life. Both kinds of work give people useful choices in the community.
- ② Coffee workers pick ripe red coffee cherries by hand when the fruit is ready. At a mill, workers remove the fruit, wash and dry the beans, and sort them before packing the beans into bags. Guides learn local trails and safety rules. They plan walks that fit the weather and the needs of their visitors.
- ③ Some coffee bags are sold to local stores and cafés, where people in Salento can buy them. Other bags are shipped to buyers in other places, including businesses that roast and sell coffee. The guiding service is received by visitors who choose a walk. These visitors pay guides for their time, knowledge, and help on the trail.

1	What good do farms in Salento produce, and what service does the community provide?	Farms produce coffee beans. The community provides guiding services, or guided walks.
2	How do workers prepare coffee beans before they are packed into bags?	They remove the fruit, wash and dry the beans, and sort them before packing them.
3	How do guides prepare to provide walks for visitors?	They learn local trails and safety rules, then plan walks for the weather and visitors' needs.
4	Who receives the coffee, and who receives the guiding service?	Coffee goes to local stores and cafés, people in Salento, and buyers or roasting businesses in other places. Visitors who choose a walk receive the guiding service.

In a coastal community, fishers produce fresh fish, and boat captains provide rides to visitors. Fishers use nets and boats to catch fish, then workers clean and pack it. Families buy the fish at the market, and visitors receive the boat rides.
